Career

Hans W. Reiners joined BASF in 1987 as Product Manager in the Textile Dyes Division. Shortly after moving to the Fiber Intermediates Division one year later, he was seconded to BASF Corporation in the USA for two years as Marketing Manager. On his return to Germany, he became Assistant to a member of the BASF AG Board of Executive Directors.

In 1995, Hans W. Reiners assumed leadership of the business unit Agricultural Products for Southern Europe in Barcelona, Spain, and, in 1998, of the department Global Marketing Crop Protection. Following the acquisition of American Cyanamid in 2000, Hans W. Reiners was responsible for the global integration of the company into BASF.

In 2001, he was appointed Head of the Crop Protection Division of the BASF Group, working initially from the USA and starting in 2004 from Limburgerhof, Germany.

In 2005, Hans W. Reiners was also made President of CropLife International, the global federation that represents the plant science industry.

From December 2005 to the end of December 2007, he led the Styrenics Division of BASF Group as President.

Since January 1, 2008, he has been President of the Performance Chemicals Division of BASF Group.

Hans W. Reiners was born in Aachen, Germany, in 1963 and studied at Aachen Technical University, where he obtained a Master of Business Administration in 1987.
